



Peer Inclusion Team (PIT Crew) Information Form

To qualify as a Peer Inclusion Team member (PIT Crew), the student

- must work well with other students / teachers
- must be eager to serve others
- must be organized, reliable and responsible
- must have at least a cumulative, **unweighted** GPA of 2.5
- must have good attendance period by period - not just daily
- must have no major behavioral issues
- must be in at least 10th (limited # accepted), 11th or 12th grade.
- **must have submitted a completed application which was approved by the PIT Crew coordinator (available on the TCHS website)**

As a Peer Inclusion Team member (PIT Crew), the student will be responsible for assisting students with disabilities by

- being a positive role model
- assisting students with organization, directions, understanding and completing tasks, reading and other duties as assigned by the peer's classroom teacher
- giving encouragement to peers
- signing in daily
- communicating with teachers regularly
- notifying the Peer Inclusion Team coordinator about absences from school
- completing assignments as assigned either in class or online
- attending Peer Inclusion Team trainings / meetings as necessary
- completing independent or group projects related to disability issues

Students need to fill out the online application which will be reviewed before final approval. There will be a limited number of slots allocated for the 21-22 school year and the PIT Crew coordinator makes the final decision about all applications.

Applications should be completed and submitted by Friday, April 23rd. Applications are accepted and reviewed in the order they are received.
