

IN ORDER TO PURCHASE A <u>RESERVED PARKING</u> <u>SPACE</u> FOR THE CURRENT SCHOOL YEAR, THE <u>STUDENT MUST:</u>

- ✓ Be a senior currently registered at Timber Creek High School
- ✓ Have a minimum cumulative 2.5 GPA
- ✓ Be cleared of ALL financial obligations to the school.

THIS YEAR WE ARE MAKING THE APPLICATION PROCESS 100% DIGITAL. PLEASE HAVE THE FOLLOWING ITEMS AVAILABLE FOR UPLOAD AS YOU FILL OUT THE GOOGLE FORM:

- ✓ Your ticket for TicketLeap
- ✓ Photocopy of your driver's license
- ✓ A photocopy of your car registration. If you registered two cars, provide photocopies of each car's registration
- ✓ A photocopy of your car insurance. If you registered 2 cars, make sure this shows both vehicles
- ✓ Photocopy of the parking agreement with initials and signatures for student and parent (please note it is TWO pages in length)

HOW DO BUY A RESERVED SENIOR PARKING PERMIT?

SENÍORS (RESERVED PARKÍNG)

- go to <u>www.tchs.ticketleap.com</u> and find the Preferred (Seniors Only)
 Parking
- Follow the <u>Step-By-Step Guide</u> on How to Buy a Reserved Parking Spot. This can be found on the pages that follow.
 - When picking your Senior Reserved Parking Space, please make sure to do this using a computer and pick 'CHOOSE YOUR OWN SEAT' in order to pick the exact parking spot you want. If not, it will randomly assign you a spot
- 3. Complete the TCHS Parking Agreement. This can be found on the TCHS Website on the Parking Page. This will need to be uploaded to the Google Form Parking Application. This is also found on the TCHS Website on the Parking Page.
- 4. Once you have purchased your parking spot, please complete the following Google Form Parking Application found on the TCHS Website on the Parking Page.. You will not receive your parking permit until all information and documentation within this Google Form is provided.

- 5. Parking decals can be picked up during Pack is Back. Students must bring the following items with them when picking up their decals:
- Driver's License
- Receipt from TicketLeap
- Signed copy of the TCHS Parking Agreement

HOW TO BUY A RESERVED SENIOR PARKING SPOT

PEFORE PURCHASING:

- ✓ Use a computer or laptop. The "Choose Your Own Seat" feature is not available on mobile.
- ✓ Please have the following with you:
 - A credit card. The cost of a reserved permit is \$70.
 - The name and student number of the senior driver.
 - The driver's license for the student driver.
 - The license plate # of the primary vehicle and secondary vehicle (secondary is optional).
 - The make, model, and color of the primary (and optional secondary) vehicle.
 - The name, email, and phone number of a parent or guardian.
- ✓ Also, you are going to want to look at the parking map to choose the spot you want. Have backups, too, in case your first spot choice has already been sold. <u>Click here to view the parking map</u> with highlighting. Click here to view the map with no highlighting.
- ✓ Students who want to guarantee spots next to each other should give their money and required information to one purchaser. One person can purchase multiple spots. The information the purchaser will need from each student is above; all of this information is required for each ticket. Spots are held once they are put into your shopping cart, and cannot be purchased by someone else while you are completing your purchase.




HOW TO BUY A RESERVED SENIOR PARKING SPOT


TO PURCHASE:

2. Please click the link that reads "CHOOSE YOUR OWN SEATS." (You must be on a laptop or desktop to use the "Choose Your Own Seats" feature. On mobile, you must use "Find Best Seats Available.")

Make sure you click "CHOOSE
YOUR OWN
SEATS" to pick your parking spot.
This feature will not show up on mobile version so you will have to do it from a computer




3. A pop-up window will display a map of the parking lot. Select the reserved section you wish to park in. There are reserved spots on both the "Stadium" side and the "Bus Loop" side.



HOW TO BUY A RESERVED SENIOR PARKING SPOT

TO PURCHASE:

4. Click on the spot you want, and then click the "add link."




If you are purchasing a spot for a friend so you can park near each other, please make sure they submit the Google Form Application on the website and they know what parking spot number they have.

HOW TO BUY A RESERVED SENIOR PARKING SPOT

TO PURCHASE:

5. You will now see your selected spot ("ticket") in the right window. Click "CLOSE."



6. To complete your purchase, enter your credit card information and the other requested information about the student driver and the vehicle(s). Note that the driver's license field is optional because seniors who do not have their license yet can buy now and wait until later in the year (when they have their license) to pick up. **No partial or full refunds will be issued!**

RULES AND TIPS FOR PAINTING YOUR SENIOR PARKING SPOT

SENIOR PARKING SPOT PAINTING:

- students must be accompanied by an adult
- Painting can only take place after school hours (after 2:30) and on the weekends

WHAT SHOULD YOU BRING?

- ✓ You must provide your own paint and painting supplies (brushes, rollers, etc.)
 - Plan to buy one brush or roller for each color of paint you will be using.
- You must use <u>latex exterior paint</u> (water based). The Waterford Home Depot and Waterford Lowes stores have been contacted and ordered extra inventory this year
 - No spray paint is to be used.
 - Do not use "Striping Paint" or any other "Raised" paint or Roofing Tar it either peels
 up or is difficult to paint over next year.
 - o No oil-based or reflective paints.
- ✓ You may need one half to one whole gallon of the color you want for the background if you want a solid background color. Keep in mind that it takes time for the paint to dry before you can add a design on top of a solid background.
 - Consider sharing paint with a friend.
- ✓ It is a good idea to bring chalk or painter's tape to map out your design on the concrete before you begin painting.
- ✓ A towel or stadium seat-- concrete is not comfortable to sit on for long periods of time!

WHAT ABOUT A DESIGN?

- ✓ Your design must be school appropriate; it cannot be in poor taste, lewd, obscene, or project a
 message of hate or intolerance. No business advertisements. No offensive language, pictures, or
 symbols. No negative or rude language.
 - Violation of these rules may result in the repossession of your parking spot.
- \checkmark You must paint inside the lines, and leave approximately 4 inches of unpainted border.
 - Do not paint on the lines or the spot number stenciled on your parking spot.
 - If you would like to collaborate with the students on one or both sides of you to create one continuous design, that is allowed, but please do not paint on the lines separating the parking spots.
 - Search online for appropriate ideas and inspiration ("Senior Parking Painting Ideas").
