



What is Science Olympiad??

Science Olympiad is a competition event where teams of up to 15 students, led by a coach, compete in 23 different events. The events are in various subjects such as, physics, chemistry, earth space science, biology and engineering. Students engage in hands-on, interactive, inquiry-based activities that are lab-based, research-based, or prebuilt. Unlike some science competitions, Science Olympiad requires that students DO science during the competition rather than just report about a science project. We meet once a week to prepare for competition.
