## Expectations of Membership 2021 – 2022

Please be advised that if you are chosen as a student in the SGA program you are agreeing and understand the following expectations:

- Have room in your schedule for the appropriate level leadership course.
- Attend after school meetings for your class council (determined by class officers) and SGA (held once a month, dates will be posted).
- Plan and attend fundraiser events such as spirit nights, car washes, candy sales, etc.
- Work 1 athletic event per quarter.
- Attend 3 TCHS activities per quarter, only one sporting event will count. Examples are plays, dance recitals, club activities, other clubs spirit nights, orchestra concert, homecoming event. Any activity sponsored by a TCHS organization.
- Volunteer outside of Timber Creek in the community 10 hours per quarter. If you are not sure if the event will count towards hours you are expected to check with the advisor before doing it, forgiveness afterwards will not apply. ☺
- Donation requests for Thanksgiving drive, WESH share your Christmas, hurricane relief projects, and other indirect service projects that the community service committee plans (all student run).
- Attend one district meeting which is held on Saturdays (3 dates to choose from).
- Work committees with special projects, additional costs may be needed or fundraised to cover as well as possible additional hours after school to complete projects. Students will be in student text groups. We do a lot of communication through text/remind.
- Help publicize all SGA events using your personal social media accounts.
- Support Children's Miracle Network Dance, 5K runs, donor drives and other activities in support of SGA's main community service project. UCF is the college we work with to raise funds for Arnold Palmer Hospital.
- The following school events are required attendance:
  - Pack is Back
  - Open House
  - Incoming Freshman Night
  - Teacher move in
  - Teacher move out
  - Homecoming events (except the dance)
- Dues required are \$65, paid on school pay. The dues cover the following:
  - Discounted homecoming ticket
  - End of the year banquet
  - 2 short sleeve shirts, 1 long sleeve shirt
  - Registration to the 3 district meetings
  - Ability to attend field trips (cost of the busses)
